Colonel (Ret) Henry Childs is Vice President of Air Force Programs at Intellectual Concepts, LLC. He is responsible for relationship building,, strategic alliance and capture management for the Air Force .

He was commissioned in the United States Air Force in April 1974 after completing Air Force Officer Training School. He is a master navigator with more than 2,700 flying hours in the B-52 and

B-1B Bomber. As an Air Force Senior Leader, he commanded several organizations and held a wide variety of operational and staff assignments. He commanded the 65th Logistics Group, where he directed Supply, Transportation, Logistics Plans, and Contracting operations involving 1500 people and a \$1.5 billion budget. Col Childs also commanded the Defense Information System Agency, Western Hemisphere Logistics Support Center, a maintenance squadron, and a logistics support squadron. He was selectively assigned to serve on a Major Command and Numbered Air Force staff, and was operations officer for Headquarters Strategic Air Command, 1st Combat Evaluation Group. Additionally, as a crew member he was the senior Standard Evaluation and training flight Radar navigator, and served as chief of current operations and logistics plans division. He also held key duties in wing bombing and navigation, training flight, and standard evaluation divisions. He was recognized as a lean logistics “expert” for Warner Robins Depot, Information, Surveillance & Reconnaissance Directorate; improved supply chain management & U2 aircraft maintenance.

Col. Childs holds a Master of Arts degree in Human Resource Development from Webster University and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science, from the University of Georgia, as well as completion of Squadron Officer School, Air Command and Staff College, and Air War College while serving in the United States Air Force.. He is also the Pastor of North Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church and is pursuing his Doctorate degree in Leadership.
